9:00 AM | BREAKFAST AT WEE BIT O'HEATHERS

Gotta start the day right, and there's no better place than Wee Bit O'Heathers. This spot's been a local favorite for over three decades, and I never pass up their eggs and hash or a slice of homemade pie. Trust me, you'll need a good breakfast before diving into the day's adventures!

10:30 AM | DUCLEAUX CELLARS

Next, head to Ducleaux Cellars, where things are always laid-back and fun. Toby Turlay and Chris Ducleaux are serious about Rhône-style wines, but they don't take themselves too seriously—my kind of place! Their Syrah Cabernet blend, Stella of the Vines is a standout for me, but enjoy their flight and see what speaks to you.

12:30 PM | EXPLORE LOS ROCOSOS VINEYARDS WITH ROGER

Alright, now it's time to swing by Los Rocosos Vineyards—my place. After 30 years in government service and my time as a proud U.S. veteran, I found a new chapter in winemaking. At Los Rocosos, I'll personally guide you through our estate vineyards and share the story of how I transitioned from serving my country to cultivating the unique volcanic soils of the Rocks District of Milton Freewater. You'll get a chance to taste Rhône varietals like Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre, all grown right here. It's a laid-back, intimate experience, with plenty of stories along the way.

Enjoy their estate-grown Bordeaux and Rhône varieties, or, if you're feeling adventurous, try their refreshing Blue Mountain Cider.

4:00 PM | POP IN FOR SOME HONEY

Stop by Sweet Bee Honey Co., a family-owned shop known for its locally sourced honey and handcrafted bee products! It is a truly unique experience. Setup your tasting online.

4:30 PM | TAKE IN MONGATA WINERY

Take a scenic drive over to Mongata Winery. As you pull up, you'll be greeted by two Great Pyrenees dogs (who love visitors!) and the stunning barn. It's a laid-back, beautiful spot to relax and taste their exceptional wines. The views and the wine are both unforgettable.

6:30 PM | DINNER AT KELLY'S RESTAURANT & LOUNGE

End the day with dinner at Kelly's, my go-to spot for a hearty meal. Whether you're in the mood for a juicy steak or something Irish-inspired, this place has it all. The lively casual atmosphere is perfect way to wrap up a day of adventures in The Rocks District of Milton Freewater. Trust me, you'll leave happy and full. No reservation necessary.
